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5) Paddling Film Festival Update

- Venue: Beringia Center reserved **April 18** (capacity 192), cost \$360 (\$60/hr)
- Paddling Film Festival fee: \$729.75 (ED needs approval for expenses over \$500)

Motion to expend \$729.75 to Reel Media for the Paddling Film Festival: Karen Second: Virginia, passed.

6) Canoe Raffle Update

- Kanoe People offered to provide prize pack this year:

7) Special Meeting

Yukon Societies Act

- YCKC classified as class B society (revenue under \$120,000 and assets under \$250,000)
- Able to waive need to have financials reviewed by accountant
- Requires special resolution at AGM or special meeting

8) YCKC program fees

- Proposed paid programing 2024:
 - Youth / adult / women & gender diverse whitewater kayak (2024 Fee: \$300)
 - ED propose adding cost of YCKC T-shirt (Yukon Apparel) & hat (~\$50), declined
 - Swiftwater Rescue with Tat Expediting (2024 covered \$100/person of Tat price x 10 participants)
- Aiming to have registration open March 1, with whitewater kayak pool session April 6th
- Annual membership pricing: leave individual and youth as is, but change family to \$60



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9) Erik Pinkerton Photography Sponsorship

- Erik has been a member for the last few years, taken on more leadership roles each year
- Would like to provide stock photos from events and for website as well as two short promotional video edits (1 general club video, 1 specific whitewater kayak video for youth program recruitment).
- · In return, he is asking for

 - He media produced will be used in his professional portfolio (YCKC will have to update media release on waivers)
