- From 2021/2022 to 2022/2023, insurance cost increased \$2400 to \$3350 (40%)
- 2021/2022 Membership: 191 (\$3180)
- 2022/2023 Membership: 269 (\$4600)

8) Executive Director budget Increase (Lawrence)

Background:

- 2022-2023 ED Budget is \$15,000 (passed March 16, 2022)
 - \$1250/month (Does not include work with KDFN or YAC)
- YTD Spending: \$14,127.50
 - \$1765.94/month for ¾ of 2022-2023 fiscal year
- Tasks not incorporated in budgeting process
 - Water License Renewal
 - CPRA Application (\$50,000)
 - CanNor EOI (\$6,000,000)
- Potential Funding to cover costs
 - CPRA \$5485 (decision Dec.22)
 - Non-profit COVID Relief and Recovery Fund \$10,000 (application deadline Dec. 31)
